From **2 to 3 March 2018**, the **RACC** organises the **Rally Catalunya Històric “Trofeu Dues Catalunyes”**: A two-day competition on closed roads, with start in Barcelona, and stopping over in France.

As part of the **Rally Catalunya Històric**, the **RACC** wants to remember the 6 editions of the **“Trofeu Dues Catalunyes”** (“Two Catalonias Trophy”), which was organised by the club for the last time back in 1965.

The Rally Catalunya, currently a scoring round towards the FIA World Rally Championship, was staged for the first time in 1957.

The **Rally Catalunya Històric “Trofeu Dues Catalunyes”** is a regularity race, split into two legs, with averages of up to 55 kph (option to choose between high and low average), and stages run on closed roads and with a night stage during the first leg.



Route

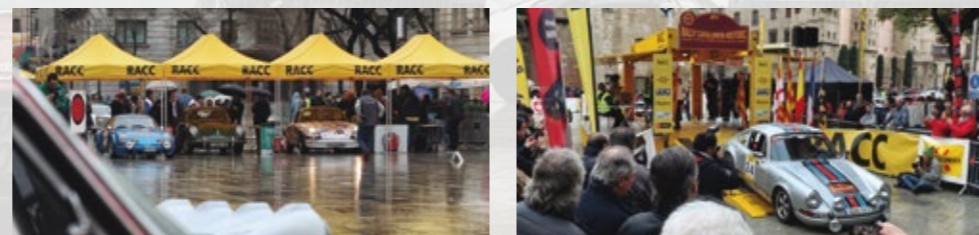
Total: approx. 700 km

Friday 2 March - Leg 1: approx. 250 km

Saturday 3 March - Leg 2: approx. 450 km

Eligible vehicles

- Vehicles built between 1947 and 1984.
- Grouped in classes E, F, G, H, I and J.
- K-class vehicles (built in 1985 and 1986) will be admitted at the discretion of the organiser, and will be eligible for the class trophy but not for the overall classification.



Premium Rally (All Included)

Entry fee: 1,300 €

RACC Members: 1,150 € (if the entered driver is an RACC member)

Participants (driver and co-driver) not having the relevant federation licence will have to pay the respective fee for the application of the respective participation permit issued by the Federation.

- Rally entry fees
- Friday (podium area, before the start): “Welcome Buffet”
- Friday: dinner at the Hotel for driver and co-driver
- Friday: hotel accommodation in a double room (breakfast included)
