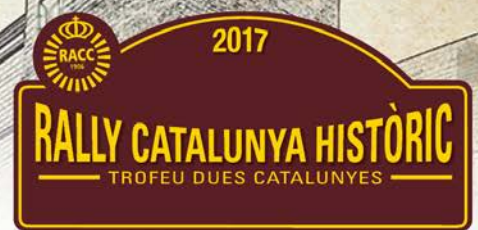

## 10. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS AND SCRUTINEERING

### Checking Procedure

On Friday, 24 February, on arrival at Av. de la Catedral, all participants must park their vehicle in the SABA Car Park, located under the square.

They will first have to undergo Administrative Checks at the RACC Truck. After the administrative paperwork, they will receive the competition numbers and rally plates, as well as a card for 2 hours of free parking in the SABA Car Park.

The competition numbers and rally plates will have to be fixed to the vehicle in the SABA Car Park, before taking the car to scrutineering.

After the scrutineering, the vehicle will be parked under parc fermé conditions in Av. de la Catedral until the time scheduled for their start from the podium.

10.2.3 The use of a 3rd braking light is authorised, including the LED light.

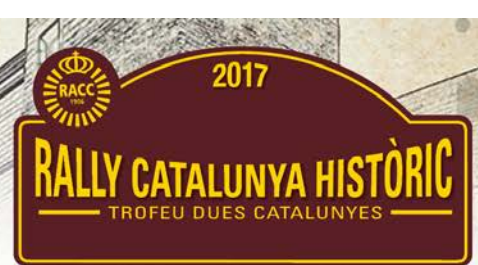
10.2.4 It is compulsory to use a helmet during the regularity stages.

## 21. REGULARITY STAGES

### 21.4 Summary of penalties

Add the following penalties to the chart:

Article		Penalty
21.2.2	Penalty for early arrival at a secret control (TIC)	0.1 points per tenth of a second
21.2.2	Penalty for late arrival at a secret control (TIC)	0.1 points per tenth of a second
23	Prohibited service	Up to 6,000 points

## 23. SERVICE

Service is not allowed in areas defined as Parc Fermé.

Team members duly accredited with a "Team" pass will be allowed to access Parcs Fermé and Regroupings to start engines, but not to carry out repairs.

## 24. PARC FERMÉ

Should it become necessary to carry out repairs during the Parc Fermé time (except in the Regroupings in Viladrau and Perpignan), participants may take out their vehicle after requesting it to the Clerk of the Course.

This action will imply a penalty (up to 6,000 points).
